

April, 2014 - Customers with Windows XP Operating Systems

After April 8, 2014, Microsoft will no longer provide security updates or technical support for Windows XP. This puts your passwords and the use of online services, like online banking, at increased risk. Security updates patch vulnerabilities that may be exploited by malware and help keep users and their data safer. PCs running Windows XP after April 8, 2014 should not be considered to be protected, and it is important that you migrate to a current supported operating system so you can receive regular security updates to protect your computer from malicious attacks.
